I strongly object to the so-called "South Fork Mountain Vegetation Management" plan, which appears to be a logging plan disguised as an emergency wildfire measure under President Trump's Executive Order 14225 and Agriculture Secretary Brooke Rollins' Secretarial Memorandum 1078-006. Building roads and removing mature timber in this area will likely increase wildfire risk, damage public lands that belong to all Americans, displace wildlife, and threaten the South Fork of the Trinity watershed—one of the few remaining places where native salmon and steelhead can still reach pristine historic spawning grounds. The erosion, runoff, silt, and debris caused by this project could devastate those spawning beds and the broader forest ecosystem for years. I urge you to reject this false "emergency" and halt the plan until biologists, neighbors, and public land users have a meaningful opportunity to weigh in and have their voices considered.
