

Appendix A Maps of Bi-state Sage Grouse Observations

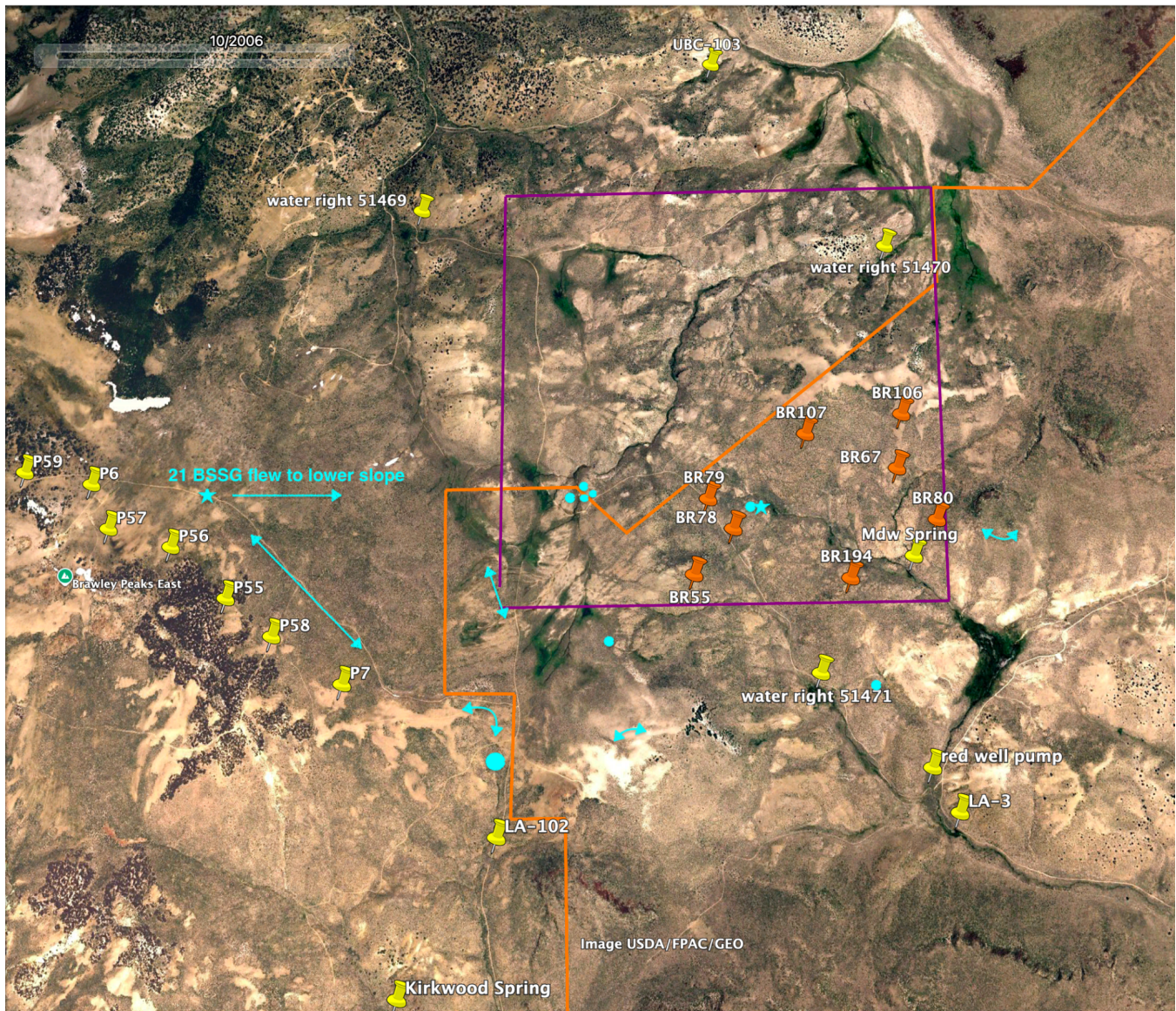


Figure 1: The light blue star on the map is where we flushed 21 sage grouse on 7-28-24 (after scoping) which flew downslope to the foot of East Brawley Peak. The blue double arrows indicate areas of numerous scat piles and/or tars. The big blue dot indicates an open area with many scat piles as we've seen at lek sites and the small blue dots are locations of a single scat pile or two. Yellow pins are the Polariss drill sites on top of East Brawley Peak. Orange pins are the Burnt Rock drill sites in the Aurora Peak Lek. Note all the green wet areas.

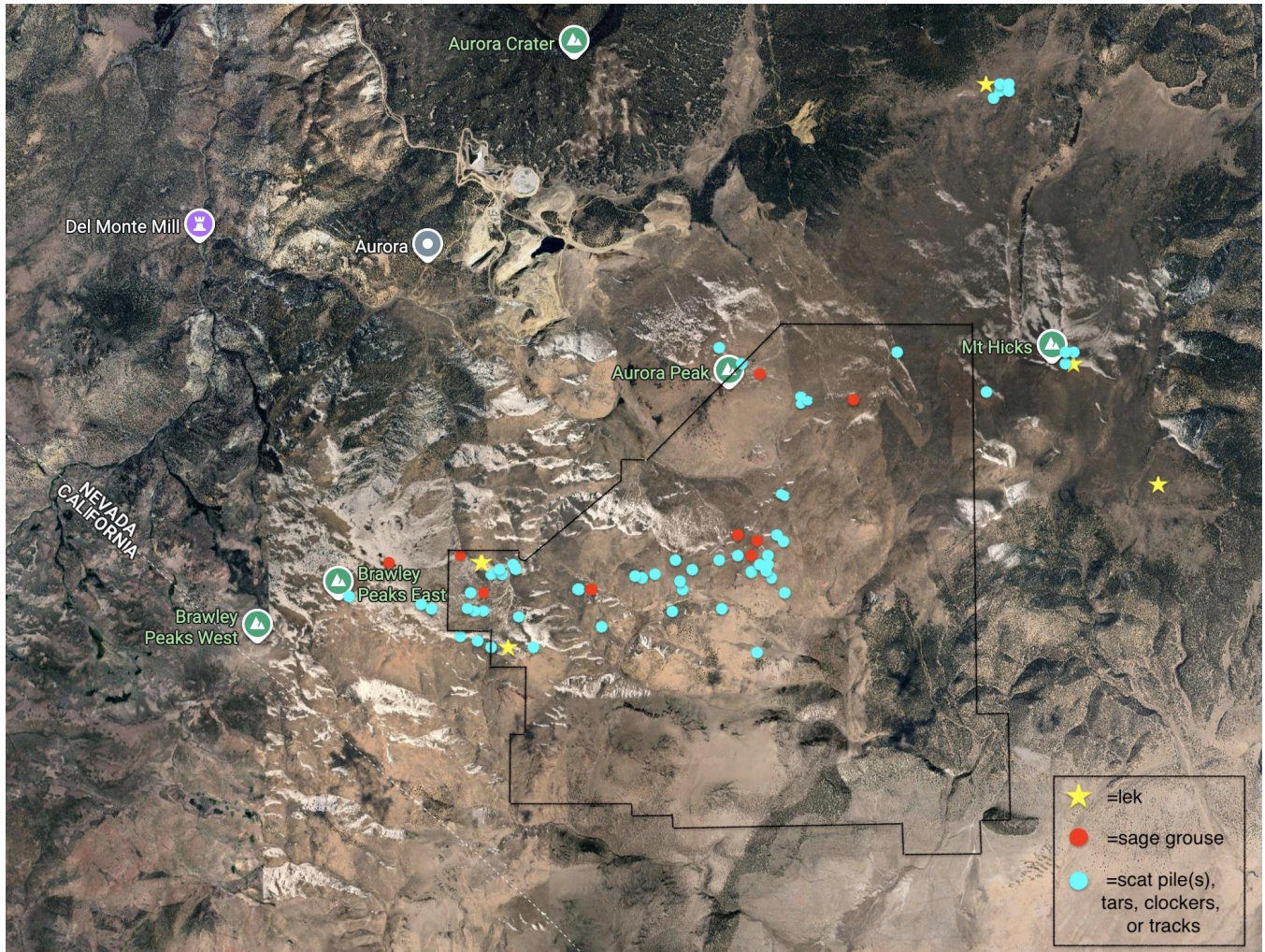


Figure 2: Where we have observed the presence of bi-state sage grouse on visits to the area since 2020. The actual lek location is in the area of one of the two stars.
