Dear Forest Supervisor Glaspell:

Keystone Resort appreciates the opportunity to comment on Arapahoe Basin's 2026 Improvement Projects and supports investments in recreational, operational, and infrastructure improvements that enhance the visitor experience and support the continued vitality of Summit County's mountain resort economy.

As part of the review process, Keystone respectfully requests that Arapahoe Basin demonstrate that removal of the existing 25% diversion limitation will not adversely affect: (1) the maintenance of instream flows on the Snake River, or (2) the rights and interests of the Colorado Department of Natural Resources and Keystone Limited Partnership in the instream flows on the Snake River and North Fork of the Snake River under the existing Memoranda of Agreement.

We believe this information will help confirm that the proposed modification can be implemented consistently with longstanding instream flow protections and existing watershed commitments. Subject to that demonstration, Keystone supports the proposed project.
