Jason,

Thank you. For clarity, and without requesting any additional search or incurring any further cost, please confirm that CPW's September 16 statement that staff "have no records" is CPW's final response to both numbered items of the August 22 request.

In other words, CPW has located no final CPW-authored analysis of whether Sweetwater Road could become impassable during an evacuation; no final CPW evaluation of the Houck report; and no final CPW comments or recommendations to the Forest Service or its consultants concerning emergency evacuation, secondary egress, evacuation capacity, or the robust emergency-response analysis CPW itself requested during scoping.

A simple confirmation is sufficient. Thank you.

Hello Larry,

I have heard back from staff regarding your request. They have advised that CPW holds no records for item 1 of your request. Regarding item 2, they have advised that they don't

believe CPW has any final comments other than what was in the comment letter provided during the NEPA scoping process and that they don't believe they have any other "official" documents. There may be emails pertaining to item 2 but it doesn't sound like the records you are asking for exist. If you would like staff to search for emails it would take them 1.5 hours. The cost to you, with no charge for the first hour, would be .5 hours @41.37/hr = \$20.68. There may be additional time/cost needed to review the emails. Dear CPW CORA Custodian:

Under the Colorado Open Records Act, I request electronic copies of the following narrowly identified records:

1. Any final CPW-authored memorandum, technical review, recommendation, or written analysis addressing whether wildfire, flooding, landslide, debris flow, rockfall, or another emergency could make Sweetwater Road/County Road 150 impassable during an evacuation of Sweetwater Lake State Park; and
2. CPW's final written comments or recommendations to the USFS or its EIS consultants concerning emergency evacuation, secondary egress, evacuation capacity, or the need for the robust emergency-response analysis requested in CPW's July 23, 2024 Sweetwater Lake scoping comments.

The relevant period is July 23, 2024 through the date of this request. Please include any final CPW evaluation or recommendation resulting from CPW's review of the 2023 Houck report, but not the Houck report itself.

Please exclude drafts, duplicate copies, routine coordination emails, and published NEPA documents. I am seeking only final CPW analysis or final comments, plus the transmitting email if the record was sent outside CPW.

Please provide electronic records only. Please limit research and retrieval to CPW's free hour. I do not authorize fees of any kind without a written estimate and my prior written approval. If the entire request cannot be

completed within the free hour, please produce the readily identifiable final records that can be located within that hour and stop further work.

Because comments on the Sweetwater Lake DEIS are due September 23, 2026, I request production as soon as practicable within CORA's deadlines.
