Guidelines

pg.113 (39-40)

Should say "Trail segments found to adversely impact natural and cultural resources should be evaluated and developed for alternative design/routes or locations where feasible. If no solution exists, trail should be evaluated for closure.

pg.114 (16-18)

Should say "Management activities occurring in areas with high potential for cross-country motorized vehicle use, should incorporate design to limit potential or utilize methods (such as barriers and signing) to control unauthorized motorized use, consistent with the scenic integrity objectives."

Management Approaches

pg. 115 (16-20)

Should say "Signing, enforcement, public information, trail use designation, seasonal and special closures, maintenance, construction, and restoration take place as appropriate. Emphasis is placed on addressing user conflicts, safety and resource damage. Educational techniques (such as brochures, signs, websites, and social media) enhance visitor knowledge of proper non-motorized and motorized trail use etiquette.
