IT IS ALSO NOT UNCOMMON TO FIND TRAILS THAT ARE BEING BUILT IN VIRGIN FOREST. I FIND OBSTACLES SUCH AS JUMPS BEING BUILT. DAMAGE IS BEING DONE TO THESE FORESTS.
