Dear Plan Revision Team,

Here is packet #2 from ACFAN et al of documents that must be reviewed and their points considered, since they reflect concerns with the 2006 Wayne Plan and subsequent activities of the Wayne. They reflect the lack of ecological management of the Wayne that would serve the public interest as required of the Forest by congressional mandate.

Please address how the new Plan will avoid the serious flaws of Wayne management to date, as detailed in the attached and other objections to proposed Wayne projects. Note that objections were never considered and plans never modified to reflect the science and facts outlined in the following:
