As a motorized user, I oppose losing any right to motorized access of these public lands. A large majority of the Chugach is already restricted to non-motorized use, and what's left shall remain intact, if not expanded, for future generations.

The rights of motorized user groups have diminished since 2002 when The Forest service initiated the Land Management plan and it must stop.
