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Comments: When restoring waterway edges, access to the waterway by the public must be allowed. This includes all waterways and not only high use waterways. As a whitewater kayaker, I access waterways that most people would not use themselves. I have noticed restriction to the waterway access at the Benham Fall recreation site that interferes with my kayaking. In this case, long-term trail access was obliterated and the access to run the falls, set safety, scout, and provide rescue was compromised. The use of waterways by the public is a right supported by the SCOTUS, the equal-footing doctrine, and every state admissions act/constitution. Please do not block the reasonable access to waterways in the name of Aquatic-Restoration.
