* Non-system Road and Trail Decommissioning: Decommission non-system roads and trails in areas covered by 36 CFR 212 Subpart A and B travel management decisions to hydrologically disconnect such routes from stream networks."

User-created trails used to access waterways for the purpose of Navigation, Fishing, and Recreation must not be completely obliterated. Reasonable access must be allowed and is supported by SCOTUS decisions, Oregon Constitution and Statue. The USFS must educate themselves about the right of the public to access waterways for the uses of Navigation, Fishing, and Recreation. The plan to decommission all non-system trails violates my right to use waterways for these purposes.

The USFS does not have the right to adopt a look-but-don't-touch philosophy for waterway management. Waterways are held in trust for the public's use. The public has the right to use waterways for Navigation, Fishing, and Recreation. Effective access must be allowed and it would be best if the USFS created this access in a sound manner.

This Aquatic-Restoration plan, as it is written, will create a WAR between the USFS and river users. This will waste resources and create ill-will. Please rewrite the plan for trail obliteration to include reasonable access for Navigation, Fishing, and Recreation.
