Currently, it seems if there are two motorized routes the area in between is designated motorized. Why non cherry stem the motorized routes and put green in between? Both groups want quick access from town, both groups want loops. Packed dirt parking pads at Divide Road and other routes will allow hikers and mountain bikers and motorized who arrive in a pickup truck with their motorcycles or ATV in the bed of the truck to park safely even when summer heat and dryness has turned tall grass to firestarters. "Don't park on top of dried grass" works better if there are enough packed dirt parking areas. Engage the public more long-term through citizen science projects.
