Comments: Thank you for taking these additional comments of mine on the CTP DEIS.

A NO ACTION alternative is the choice needed for this document.

It is incumbent upon the USFS to abide by an earlier decision of the 4th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals in Richmond, Va. when they cited 'The Lorax' by Dr. Suess:

"We trust the United States Forest Service to speak for the trees, for the trees have no tongues."

Unfinished business from old projects that are having negative effects on the forest need addressed before any large landscape project proceeds.

The 452 red pipes noted on page 160 in the CTP DEIS need to be reviewed, repaired, replaced or removed. And the Forest Service needs to adequately and transparently demonstrate that the "maladministration" issues found in the 2016 Forest Service report reviewing two timber sales be resolved with a complete accounting.

In the decision citing "The Lorax" the Judges stated that the USFS "abdicated its responsibility to preserve national forest resources". For the Tongass: the place and the people and the trees with no tongues we need the No Action Alternative.
