I have been heavily engaged in this project for the last two years. I have sat on an Advisory Group Committee associated with the Town of Minturn, in that capacity I have spoken at the HCE Board Meeting and County Commissioners Mangers Meeting.

I was blind sided that this project is now open for public comment. 8 months ago, HCE committed to working with both the benefiting municipalities, from Vail to Gypsum, and the County to explore additional funding measures. They have been radio silent in that effort.
