Snow sports users (including Keystone's one-of-a-kind Ski Bike program) would benefit from a 'back bowl' type experience to develop an interest in manageable 'off piste' but inbounds terrain.

My only concern is in terms of Scenic Resources, Trail 16-05 appears excessively wide. This is most obvious in the orthographic view I've attached labeled 'excessive width'. It would seem that this trail is wider than needed for circulation, and in viewing from top-down, is wider than wide sections of Mozart or other trails at Keystone.

Trail width is a factor in the retention of view quality and forest appearance. A huge 'expressway' down the center of the drainage with a lift at the side is not in keeping with a 'back bowl' location and experience, away from base facilities.
