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Comments: To whom it may concern. Do not remove the protections for all trees over 21 inches in diameter (DBH) in Oregon's Eastside tree dominated ecosystems on federal public lands. We must protect all large and older trees in attempts to save native species that depend on them for their survival as well as to protect the human species. I surmise the human species is on its way to extinction in the next 50 years if all agencies and the people within don't quickly and drastically reverse course.

The US Forest Service has no ecological justification to remove these protections for the last remaining large trees on federal public lands east of the Cascade Crest in Oregon.
