As a long-time forester in the State of West Virginia, I have had concerns regarding the health of Monongahela National Forest (MNF) for many years. It is no secret that forestlands can not flourish unless they are consistently benefiting from sound silvicultural practices and I fear that the MNF has not had such an opportunity for quite some time.
