Since the last open comment period for the North Shore project, the Mendocino National Forest continues to push for broad post-fire logging across hundreds and thousands of acres throughout multiple watersheds. The intense soil disturbance from heavy machinery on these sensitive soils would only increase the spread of invasive plant species across the forest. Please do not worsen this threat to native ecosystems and consider the cumulative impacts.
