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Comments: Hi; I lived in a shed on the east side of the island off road for the better part of 30 years. I value the quite and peace of the forest. The changing weather and fairly sparse population of wildlife make it an interesting experience and a good place to write. Thus in my opinion virtually any similar location would be fine for visitors; especially if there is a trail to a beach and possibly a connecting trail to the road system on the East side of the island.

The east side of Wrangell Island is mostly a dark area without cell service or internet access. One lives there as if one were here before mankind settled the region perhaps 30,000 years ago to a certain extent. With luck one can track wolves in winter for a photo op, or a moose will visit on the way to a higher munching experience.

I would suggest that the existing Wrangell spur road/Izeyama Drive or Reagan High Road to Pats Creek Road be made into a through-put trail for marathon jogging and nature viewing. A Cabin at one of the high spots with an overlook of the fabulous mountains above Virginia Lake would be great- especially if a cell tower amplifier was placed somewhere to provide coverage to the people that live on the East side of the island.
