This is what one of our daughters saw after burn on similar terrain, vegetation, elevation, and orientation in Hunter Creek above Aspen this summer

Hi Dad,

I assume that the FS has seen the results of the HC controlled burn and know what they're doing (I really hope so!).

What I saw is that it killed the aspen trees by exploding their trunks and even those that seemed to have intact trunks had their new spring leaves scorched, so they looked like they wouldn't survive. There were many standing, dead, partially burnt aspens and pines and a sign warning people of the danger of them falling on the trail. A thick growth of baby aspens and other bushes and plants was coming up in the burned areas.
