5.Issues: Fens and fen peat are not recognized as a "carbon store" in the Final EIS v.1, Chapter 3 and the

GMUG Plan Revision. Despite the following statement in the Final EIS v1, Chapter 2 (page 1-22), FW-DC-RMGD-02: "The species composition provides the ecosystem services of water and carbon storage (particularly

in fens-which are among the most carbon-dense ecosystems on the planet...", fens and fen peat were not recognized as nonforested carbon stores in the GMUG carbon assessment.

6.#5 could be remedied by including fens and fen peat in the GMUG carbon analysis and GMUG Plan.

7.In 2021 (Austin GMUG comments 11/23/21), I commented on peat in the western U.S. not being a renewable resource because the Histosol represents thousands of years of organic material accumulation (USFWS 1999). This links to this objection letter content.
