It is a lopsided exchange that heavily favors the landowners in the East Crazies and rewards them for blocking public access to our National Forest lands. It appears to be an exercise to have the appearance of solving a problem of public access and checkerboard land ownership in the East Crazies when it actually makes the access more difficult for the public. It also makes future development in the lower elevation lands easier for the private landowners.
