Attached is the current trail system showing the public trails, additional to this we have another 5 trails on private property as well as our 2024 operating plan as part of the Roughrider Rendezvous permitting process. Our club has been recreating on these trails since the mid-1980s and average monthly outings to the trail system. Below are a list of pointed items or questions we are excited to continue the conversation on.

- Cliffhangers 4x4 Club requests that all of the trail system is maintained in its entirety as established today to maintain a variety of difficulty of trails and keep overusage of smaller quantity of trails down. (see attached trail map)
- Cliffhangers 4x4 Club requests that a process to establish additional trails in the future is created and clearly defined.
- Cliffhangers 4x4 Club requests an opportunity to meet with engineers, USFS leadership, and USFS staff prior to the initial trail map being presented.
- Cliffhangers 4x4 Club requests that if an established OHV area is created, we have the ability to consult and advise the creation of the area.
- Cliffhangers 4x4 Club would advocate for an individual state or Grasslands permit for individual motorized vehicles, UTVs, motorcycles, etc.
- How does the USFS intend to regulate or permit users of the area?
- Does the USFS intend to educate users in proper recreation in the area?
- What if any environmental, biological limitations in terms of time are being considered?
- Are there any enforcement standards the USFS would implement?
- How will event permitting be different if this area is set as an open OHV area?
