Comments: The Alaska Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Division of Forestry & Fire Protection (DOF) reviewed the Forest Service Manual 2470, Silvicultural Practices, and recommends the following: Consider compiling specific Indigenous Knowledge into a written compendium that is accessible to all foresters and silviculturists. The change allowing for the consideration of Indigenous Knowledge in the preparation of detailed silvicultural prescription is embedded throughout the update. DOF encourages the U.S. Forest Service (FS) to begin compiling and explaining Indigenous Knowledge into a written compendium that is accessible to all foresters and silviculturists. As site-specific application of Indigenous Knowledge begins to be implemented through detailed silvicultural prescriptions, having access to a written synopsis of the applicable Indigenous Knowledge and how it influences on-the-ground management will be useful to foresters and silviculturists not only within the FS, but outside it as well, to include non-federal public and private, forest managers. DOF recommends that the compendium be a living document that is expanded as Indigenous Knowledge is continually obtained through consultation on future project work.
