Comments: I have hiked and backpacked in the Great Burn for years. I strongly support Option A for the Hoodoo Roadless Area. Please eliminate Option B creating a motorized rec. management area. If these motorized corridors are allowed there is no way that the USFS will manage them effectively. The lack of coordination between the Lolo NF and the Nez-Clear during the planning process is worrisome and if an indication of how cross FS boundaries/state lines will be manages a nightmare will ensue. The recommended wilderness boundaries in Option A should be reduced to protect the unity of the area for wildlife. The importance of that area for wildlife corridors can not be stressed enough. Animals can come down thru the Missions thro the Burn and out into the SWBW. I have personally seen a wolverine on the road to crooked fork trailhead so they are using the great burn.
