Mr. Sanders,

Attached is the map of where the different treatments would be conducted. The treatment levels are not fully decided, and are being developed during the public scoping phase. We have these treatment levels delineated due to various factors, including wildlife considerations, WUI, ingress / egress routes.

We would not ignite any piles unless there was sufficient fuel and ambient moisture levels to allow safe prescribed fire use. This means that if the drought continues, we would not ignite the piles until there was sufficient fuel moistures for us to not be concerned with escape.

We will consider your input in the development of our project, please be in touch if you have more input to provide.
