Comments: I write to you today both as a long-time resident of Idaho and as an elected member of the state Senate. It is in both of these capacities that I want to express my support for Midas Gold Idaho's proposed Stibnite Gold project. This project - with its potential for economic opportunity for Idaho and the only plan to finally clean up and restore the historic Stibnite mining district - is exactly the kind of opportunity we need here in the Gem State.

The Stibnite Mining District, has a long history but unfortunately has been left in a lackluster condition following decades of activity that occurred without t he rigorous regulations in place today. Midas Gold's commitment to redevelop this site is a chance for the area to be restored without any taxpayer resources expended. Specifica lly, Midas Gold is prepared to make a \$1 billion investment in Idaho, with part of that money dedicated to completing their Plan of Restoration and Operations (PRO), which includes a robust reclamation plan to ensure the site is returned to a healthy and thriving ecosystem.

Other parts of the \$1 billion investment wil I be used to generate capital and jobs in our state. Highland Economics, an independent firm which conducted an economic analysis of the project, estimates the generation of more than \$28 million annually in local income during construction. This is an incredible investment for a state that consistently ranks as one with the lowest per capita income. Annual estimated incomes will increase during the operations phase - the longest period of the project - to more than \$29 million. Income generation of this magnitude also means significant tax revenues for municipalities.

Midas Gold has offered a project that the state needs. They've already committed and spent more than \$150 million dollars in our communities, with millions more on the way. Private investment and environmental reclamation will do significant things for us all. I encourage you to adopt Alternative 2 examined in the draft Environmental Impact Statement and move this project forward.
