I have been closely following Midas Gold Idaho's plans for several years as an investor. I am excited to have the opportunity to comment on their Draft EIS. Midas Gold Idaho presents a huge opportunity for the citizens of Idaho.

The Stibnite Gold Project will bring huge economic benefits to Idaho, particularly in Valley County. Midas Gold will invest a billion dollars in the project and restore a nearby river. The Project will employ 400-500 employees during construction and operations. Payroll is expected to exceed \$34 million.
