I am writing to let you know I am against the Golden Peak Race Course expansion. First and foremost Golden Peak is beautiful and should be protected from development. That aspen grove is one of the most beautiful ones on the I-70 Corridor that should be protected for future generations. Second, as we saw this year millions of gallons of water melted at the early season low elevation of Golden Peak. Building a race course at lower elevation doesn't make sense for the environment nor VR's business. Why don't they use terrain above 10,000 ft. that holds better such as what Copper Mtn. does. Weather is changing as we know and it's crucial that we protect these beautiful areas with Colorado's extreme growth. I work for Vail Resorts so would rather not give my information but as I've said above I'm against the un-needed project other than for revenue.
