I feel that the USFS lands need to be allowed to be leased for oil and gas exploration/production. The counties that these leases are located in tend to be poorer and more economically undeveloped which results in them (the counties) needing the money. Further, I think more lands need to be allowed to be leased than just the parcels that are nominated by interested parties (oil and gas companies) (wildcat acreage) - nominated by the USFS itself.
