The staff of the Wyoming Game and Fish Department (Department) has reviewed the Landscape Vegetation Analysis (LaVA) Project Modified Final Environmental Impact Statement (MFEIS) and Draft Record of Decision. We offer the following comments for your consideration.

The Department has been actively involved as a cooperator in the LaVA project since its inception. We believe projects implemented through LaVA will provide many benefits to wildlife and forest resiliency. The Department has funding and resources for a number of projects through our Mule Deer Initiative to improve mixed mountain shrub and aspen habitats in big game summer and transitional range habitats.

We believe the Adaptive Implementation and Monitoring Framework will provide more opportunities for both public and cooperator input than standard National Environmental Policy Act analysis, will streamline project implementation, and will ensure resources are protected through monitoring and reporting.

We look forward to working with the Forest Service and other stakeholders to implement wildlife habitat improvement projects under LaVA.
