Dear Mr. Macfarlane:

This letter is in response to your objection filed on the Canyon Lake Dam Access Environmental Assessment (EA) and Draft Decision Notice released by Matt Anderson, Forest Supervisor of the Bitterroot National Forest. I have read your objections and reviewed the project record. My review of your objection was conducted in accordance with the administrative review procedures found at 36 CFR 218, Subparts A and B.

ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW PROCESS

The regulations at 36 CFR 218.8 provide for a pre-decisional administrative review process in which the objector provides sufficient narrative description of the project, specific issues related to the project, and suggested remedies that would resolve the objections.

RESPONSE TO OBJECTIONS

As specified at 36 CFR 218.11(b), I must provide a written response to your objections; however, this response need not be point by point. The review of your objection issues is included as an attachment to this letter and will be posted on the project website.

Regarding your request to visit the dam site with Forest Service personnel, District Ranger Winthers or his representative will contact you to arrange a field trip as soon as weather/terrain conditions allow safe travel.

CONCLUSION

My review finds that the project is in compliance with all applicable laws and the Bitterroot National Forest Plan (1987). The Forest Supervisor may sign the Decision Notice for this project. My review constitutes the final administrative determination of the Department of Agriculture; no further review from any other Forest Service or Department of Agriculture official of my written response to your objection is available [36 CFR 218.11 (b)(2)].
