The Town of Rico continues to support U.S.F.S. efforts on the multi-use trail project referred to as the Rico Trails Project. The Town supports the third proposed alternative action on the project, which includes a seasonal closure of the Ryman Creek Trail between May 15th and June 30th each year to protect elk during spring calving season.

Rico's economy is heavily dependent on outdoor recreation and this project will provide improvements that will make recreational experiences in the area more enjoyable for both visitors and residents.

The project as proposed will provide a broad range of experiences for hikers and mountain bikers of all ability levels. The project will also provide connection for motorized trails that were fragmented.
