I am writing you to express my support for the Midas Gold Idaho's Stibnite Gold Project. After examination of the recently released draft of the Environmental Impact Statement for the project I can see that both the company and regulators have worked hard to consider would be best for Idaho. I appreciate the work that has been done to protect Idaho's environment and precious natural resources. That is why I support this 21st Century mining proposal.

A hundred years of mining in the Stibnite area has greatly harmed the environment. The abandoned pits, accelerated erosion, and elevated metals in surface and ground waters have harmed Idaho and marred its natural beauty. As laid out in their Plan of Restoration and Operations (PRO), Midas Gold Idaho is committed to cleaning up and restoring the environment surrounding the mine site.
