**Amendment#: 2**

This amendment is attached to and made a part of the special use authorization issued to **Holland Lake Lodge, INC.** of **1947 Holland Lake Lodge Rd, Condon, MT, 59826.** on **August 19, 2022.** which authorizes the permittee to use National Forest System lands on the **Swan Lake Ranger District** of the Flathead National Forest for **Drilling Two New Wells for Pump Testing**, which is hereby amended as follows:


Authorize drilling of two new wells behind the existing storage shed and BBQ pit for pump testing. The equipment for well installation will include a rotary drill rig, which is mounted on a truck (typically a 40-foot long, 10-wheel truck). Additionally, a second large flatbed truck will be used to transport the 20-foot long steel casing. Borehole drill cuttings extracted will be piled and will not exceed an area of 10 feet x 10 feet. The drilling process uses water to loosen cuttings in the borehole so the extracted material is a resulting slurry. After drilling is complete, the cuttings will be removed with an excavator and the area will be revegetated. No drilling pad will be constructed.

It is essential to use hay bales/silt fences and push the slurry to a low spot or into a temporary pit, allowing water to seep back into the ground. Slurry is not allowed to run into the lake or the wetland just East of the lodge.

Authorize a Holland Lake Lodge Inc. representative to sign permit applications.

This Amendment is accepted subject to the conditions set forth herein, attached hereto, and made a part of this Amendment.
