Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Colville National Forest's Land and Resource Management Plan Revision.

Please add language to the protections to better preserve the old trees. Old trees are essential wildlife habitat. Also make sure that is an enforcement mechanism built in that will work.

The following wild roadless areas on the Colville National Forest should be designated as wilderness: Profanity, Bald Snow, Hoodoo, Abercrombie-Hooknose, Salmo-Priest Adjacent, Thirteenmile, and Quartzite.

We favor Alternative P for its goals to restore ecological resilience, reduce damaging roads, and increase use of fire as a restoration tool. But Alternative P falls far short in protecting large old trees, watershed health, and wilderness quality lands, and in other areas. As part of the Forest's Land and Resource Management Plan revision, I urge you to adopt Alternative P after adding explicit safeguards for large old trees, improving aquatic habitat protections and habitat connectivity, and adding the wilderness recommendations noted above.
