Comments: My name is Clint Green I'm located in Moses Lake WA, I run cattle with my Dad on the Lake Ellen allotment in the Colville National Forest.

I feel that the implementation of "ARCS" should be overseen by range specialists so that they can be site specific as to vegetation height, as many of the streams do not have vegetation that grows more than 2-3" in height. And many are not fish bearing.

I feel that the implementation of road closures should be sight specific and over seen by range specialists so as to not impact the ability of permittee's to maintain fences and water systems (closing certain roads would make maintenance on fences and watering systems extremely difficult or impossible) and may make moving, gathering or hauling of livestock difficult or impossible.

Closing certain roads would also make fire prevention or fighting difficult or impossible making it difficult for the Forest service to protect permittee's livestock.
