I don't think any of the alternatives offered in this DEIS are viable. It is difficult to understand what the motivation for preparing this sale is. The proposed cuts are scattered around the island and it is hard to imagine who will bid on these areas. The costs of this sale to the taxpayers of the United states are far too high. The miles of new roads proposed in the logging alternatives would fall on the backs of US taxpayers, who should not pay for road building to clear cuts. Clearcutting should not be allowed in the Tongass and are not allowed in any other national forest.

The DEIS says that most of the proposed logging is planned to occur in the mixed age stands of timber. The largest of these is nearest to
