Comments: I moved to Idaho when I was two years old, and have grown up exploring Idaho's mountains, rivers, and backcountry all my life. I love Idaho deeply. As an Idahoan, I am opposed to Midas Gold reopening the pit mines near the East Fork of the South Fork of the Salmon River.
