Comments: Atlantic Coast Pipeline Decision Objection

My name is Tom Snarr, and I live in Edinburg, Va.in Shenandoah County.

I am writing to object to the Forest Service's Record of Decision concerning the proposed Atlantic Coast Pipeline (ACP), specifically in its plans for crossing of the George Washington and Monongahela National Forests.

I strongly urge the Forest Service to issue an amended Record of Decision which denies permission for the Atlantic Coast Pipeline to pass through the George Washington and Monongahela National Forests. This project poses the threat of unmitigatable damage to forest habitats in the GWNF and MNF.

There is also no sufficient cumulative analysis for the ACP, rendering the Record of Decision incomplete.

The Forest Service is also clear violation of its duty to comply with the National Environmental Policy Act by not including mandatory information which was not included in the prematurely issued DEIS by FERC.
