Comments: The Uncompanded Plateau region of the GMUG lacks non-motorized trails open to mountain bikes. Cyclists, hikers and equestrian users should be provided trail opportunities away from mechanized users like motorcycles and ATVs and the noise, speed, and danger that these users pose to other trail users.

That said, many motorized trails can be greatly improved for usability and to reduce the huge erosion problem with these trails, many of which are user-created. The Spring Creek ATV trail should be replaced with a motorized single track trail connecting the excellent Forest Fence Trail to the Lower Spring Creek Trail. Portions of Forest Fence Trail should be rerouted away from roads and steep slopes to avoid conflicts with full sized vehicles on adjacent roads, and reduce erosion. Steep portions of many other trails should be rerouted to reduce erosion: Red Canyon Trail, Paradox Trail, Buck Trail, Dry Creek Trail, Hornet Trail, Clear Creek Trail, and others.
