In the Tribal assessment on page 2, in the first paragraph "Preservation Act, (NHPA)" -> "Preservation Act (NHPA),"

In the Tribal assessment on page 3, in the last paragraph "across the GMUG and impacted by" -> "across the GMUG and are impacted by" ?

In the Tribal assessment on page 4, in the 2nd bullet "on Uncompandere Plateau" -> "on the Uncompandere Plateau" (same as what is in the 1st bullet).
