This was signed by Gene Gibson 11/23/94 and approved by Gary Benes, Gene Gibson, David Garber and David Jolly in May and November of 1994. Historic use was agreed upon in 1994, and it is now 2018 with the WSA closed since 1977. This needs to be included in your process and procedures.
