Comments: I understand the Forest Service is analyzing the impacts of making available for lease approximately 54,000 acres of National Forest System (NFS) land in the Ruby Mountains portion of the District, and that if made available, these lands may be proposed for oil and gas leasing by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) in a future BLM lease sale. I would like to express my opposition to making these lands available for oil and gas leasing. This is a National Forest and it should be limited to forest uses.
