west of the Slate River Road and north of the Oh-be-joyful portion of the Raggeds Wilderness Area should be recommended to Congress as appropriate for Wilderness because it is inaccessible for mechanized and motor vehicles, provides important wildlife habitat and has not been altered by humans.
