Comments: As a native Eugenian, I have witnessed the increased foot and bike traffic on the McKenzie trail, specifically over the last five years. The trail is less enjoyable when it is busy and full of people who don't respect nature. Instead of making the Blue Pool more accessible I think a good alternative would be to make it less accessible with a day use fee and no parking lot. I have heard rumors of a cutoff trail for mountain bikers that will circumvent a lot of hikers going to the Blue Pool from the west trailhead, which will help with erosion and other impacts to natural resources. A day use fee from the west entrance would mitigate traffic. Folks are less likely to access the Blue Pool from the east entrance at Carmen Reservoir because it is a farther distance and less scenic. Make them work for it if they don't want to pay a fee.
