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Comments: I live full time below McCoy Park in Arrowhead in a property I have owned for 20 years. The Elk herd that lives above me and in McCoy (trails closed seasonally for calving season) is under enough pressure without having the additional noise and traffic from alpine skiing. It will also be enough to drive the longtime resident mountain lion out of the area. Alpine skiers/riders will be tempted to go out of bounds and ski down from trails like Wildside down into Arrowhead mountain itself (some already do) further disrupting area wildlife. The idea that it will somehow provide powder skiing for beginners is ridiculous. It is lower than the green runs off of the Red Buffalo Express lift and will be skied off quickly. McCoy is a unique wildlife area (I have not seen snow weasels anywhere else in the area) and should be preserved.
