When I learned of the Beaver Creek Resort - McCoy Park Terrain Development project, I was excited by the prospect of new terrain to spread out the flow of skier traffic. McCoy Park would add about 250 acres to The Resort's skiable terrain and include 17 trails - most that are groomable. With two new lifts (that avoid wetlands), access to McCoy Park would be made possible through three skiways from the top of Larkspur Express, Strawberry Park Express and Upper Beaver Creek Mountain Express. There also will be new trails for cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. This seems like a responsible growth plan for the increase in skiers over the years.

Since tourism is a major economic factor for this area, the plan provides a solid solution to the record skier visitors and builds on the Vail Resorts' commitment to invest in its mountain resorts and elevate the guest experience. Beaver Creek Resort is renowned for its on- and off-mountain offerings and this proposal supports those growth plans.
