In September of last year I hiked into the area recommended by the Forest Service for Wilderness in 2007, Granite Basin. I was in a small hiking group. We hiked the full length of the Horse Basin Trail. We never saw any other people during our 4-5 mile hike. The entire area was untouched nature except for the simple, single file trail itself.
