When new development is needed it should be balanced with conserving other areas forever from new trails and development.

The GMUG revision should place wildlife as one of the most important resources when approached by new development on the Forest. Once the wildlife lose habitat it will never be available for them again. I am sad that wildlife is not listed higher in the scoping done so far.

Also in this scoping process I am very unhappy that the campground toilets are locked in the fall, winter, and spring. This process is crazy as people use these lands ALL YEAR!! The outhouse is already built just locked, so people must spread their waste out in the forest.

The commercial recreation permitting process is also in need of review. With the loss of equestrian horse days across the forest new days should become available in areas that have lost these days. Every year I get calls from public wishing to visit a specific area of the forest. The outfitter with the permit will not or can't take them, and since I don't have the permit for the area the service is not available to the public. Please consider these thoughts in the scoping process.
