Lee Canyon would benefit from greater lift access. More skiable acres reduces crowding which increases safety along with skier enjoyment. A new, ADA compliant lodge is needed and would be paid for with more customers enjoying expanded skiing and snow boarding. As a retired, natural resource economist (PhD) it is my opinion that concerns over such things as the blue butterfly can't be that important as long as wild Mustangs --a non-native species -- are allowed to trample freely through butterfly habitat on a daily basis. Please allow the Lee Canyon expansion.
